ACCESS TO FISH CANYON TRAIL CANCELED DUE TO HEAVY RAIN

New Access Date Announced: Saturday, January 30

AZUSA, Calif., (January 19, 2010) – Vulcan Materials Company, Western Division, has cancelled access to Fish Canyon Trail through its Azusa Rock Quarry site previously scheduled for Saturday, January 23.

“With the heavy rains, safe access to the trailhead is very limited and we have determined it necessary to cancel the January 23 access date,” said Atisthan Roach, Community and Media Relations Manager for Vulcan. “However, we are looking forward to providing access to Fish Canyon Trail, weather conditions permitting, the following Saturday, January 30. We invite the community to take advantage of this beautiful hike to Fish Canyon Falls.”

On Saturday, January 30, Vulcan will open its gates to the Azusa Rock site at 7:00 a.m. Shuttles to the trailhead will run throughout the morning, with the last trip up at 12:00 p.m. All hikers must return to the Azusa Rock site by 3:00 p.m. As a safety measure, please note that all hikers will be asked to sign-in so an accurate head count can be maintained. This trail access will be cancelled in the event of heavy rain.

Directions:

From the 605 North and 210 East -- exit at Mount Olive and make a right onto Foothill, make a left turn onto Encanto Parkway.

From the 210 West -- exit at Irwindale Avenue and make a right, make a left turn onto Foothill, then a right turn onto Encanto Parkway.
